### **NEW COVERED WAVE BUS SHELTERS**

Okaloosa County staff has installed two new covered bus shelters at White Wilson Medical Center and the Fort Walton Beach Medical Center in Fort Walton Beach for patrons of the WAVE public bus service.

In addition to the two new shelters, a covered shelter was installed at the Boardwalk on Okaloosa Island early this year, as well as, covered shelters being available for WAVE riders at the Santa Rosa Mall, Uptown Station and the Crestview City Hall.

Funds for the new shelters were provided by a Federal grant and additional shelters are planned for other WAVE bus service routes when funding becomes available.
